

Crafts – Legos County & State Fair Projects

This project will encourage the 4-H member to use his/her imagination and ingenuity in creating an exhibit for the 4-H fair. Overall design, construction techniques, soundness, sturdiness, and balance will be some of the criteria used to judge this project.

Level 1	Grades 3, 4, & 5
Level 2	Grades 6, 7, & 8
Level 3	Grades 9 and above

General Rules

All exhibits can be of a “free design”, “original design”, or kits. If a kit is used it must be at the proper age level or above. The beginning exhibits should be simple and should become more complex as you advance through the categories. The use of the word “Lego” is used only as a guide for this project. You are free to use any brand of plastic snap-together or connecting pieces to complete your project. Decals and other materials are optional to use with your display.

Exhibit Requirements

Level I – Grades 3-5

Exhibit: Build a “fictional” character or “thing”. Examples could be: an animal, a person, a statute, a totem pole, etc. OR a structure (building such as a house, skyscraper, barn, etc.) or a vehicle (car, truck, tractor, plane, farm implement, boat, etc.) NO motorized units will be allowed in this category.

Level II – Grades 6-8

Exhibit: Build two of any related objects (new exhibits) from Level I. Examples could be: two animals, two statutes, two cars, two trucks, planes, farm implement, etc. NO motorized units will be allowed in this category.

Level III – Grades 9 -12

Exhibit: Build a display of at least three objects (new exhibits) that are related to each other. Such as a tractor and two other pieces of machinery, a set of 3 buildings, 3 cars or 2 cars and a boat. Use your imagination and have fun. Motorized units will be allowed in this category.

The display will be limited to 24” x 24” x 36 for all levels and must be displayed on a sturdy base such as plywood no more than 2” larger than each side of the constructed exhibit.
