TRACTOR-County & State Fair Project

State Fair Exhibits may total 4, one from each level.

A completed record sheet signed by your 4-H Leader **must** be presented, along with your exhibit, at project check-in at the fair.

This project is divided into four levels according to the following breakdown:

Level AGrades 3 & 4Level CGrades 7, 8, & 9Level BGrades 5 & 6Level DGrades 10 and above

General Rules

- 1. All posters must be 22" x 28", exhibited horizontally, must have a firm backing and a transparent covering.
- 2. Place a small label in the lower right hand corner of posters, notebooks and displays, with the following information: Name, Grade/Age, Club, Project and Level.
- 3. Refer to "How To Prepare A Poster Project" in this handbook for details on preparing posters.
- 4. Display boards differ from posters in that real objects are normally used, rather than drawings or pictures. Three-dimensional items are attached to the board.
- 5. It is recommended/suggested that all posters, notebooks, and display boards include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the
 - 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed or a lack thereof.
- 6. Tractor project members may also complete the project by participating in the Petroleum Power Operators' Contest.

General Rules for Interactive Demonstrations

- 1. Interactive demonstrations may be given on any topic related to the Tractor project and will be presented at an appointed time during the 4-H Fair.
