

## **CRAFTS – MODELS-County & State Fair Project**

There will be a minimum of 2 State Fair exhibits selected from this project.

A completed record sheet signed by your 4-H leader **must** be presented, along with your exhibit, at project check-in at the fair.

This project is divided into three levels according to the following breakdown:

<b>Level 1</b>	Grades 3, 4, & 5
<b>Level 2</b>	Grades 6, 7, & 8
<b>Level 3</b>	Grades 9 and above



### **General Rules**

Exhibit must be a small scale replica and meet the following criteria:

- Must be of injected styrene plastics
  - At least 25% of the exhibit must be painted
  - Wood, paper, clay, die-cast, or snap together models are not permitted
  - Screws are not permitted
  - Pre-painted or pre-decaled factory models are not permitted
  - If the model is being built from a kit, include a copy of the instructions with the craft information card.
1. Models such as snap-together plastic, wood, die cast, Lego built models, etc. do not fit in this project and must be entered in Miscellaneous Crafts. (Die cast models are metal models that are held together mostly with screws.)
  2. The model(s) must be mounted on a piece of supportive material such as lightweight wood, styrofoam, mirror, heavy cardboard, etc.
  3. The size of the supportive material should be in proportion to the size of the model(s).
  4. Exhibit should increase in difficulty with each year project is taken.
  5. Attach to project 4-H 618A-W, "4-H Craft Information Card" for description of work completed on the project.
  6. If multiple pieces make up the exhibit, a photograph of the complete exhibit should be attached to the exhibit so the total exhibit can be properly displayed. For safety purposes, any craft exhibit that resembles a sword, knife, or look-alike weapon will be judged but will not be displayed.

**Exhibit Requirements** (4-H Craft Information Card 4-H 618A-W, describing work completed on the project, must be attached to the exhibit.)

**Level 1** - Exhibit an unpainted model. (Decals are acceptable)

**Level 2** - Exhibit one or two painted models.

**Level 3** - Exhibit: 1. Three to five painted models **or** 2. One large difficult model
