CROPS

RULES:

- 1. Community Judging of all 4-H Crops projects will be at Project Check-In.
- 2. An individual may exhibit one of each division
- 3. There will be one Grand Champion selected for each varietal.
- 4. All exhibits must be from the current year's crops.
- 5. Corn and soybean plants will be judged on the basis of freedom from nutritional deficiency, root and stalk development, freedom from disease and insect damage, and general appearance and uniformity.
- 6. All crops, including wheat, will be disposed of, unless you specify your wishes to pick up your crops. This must be done at entry of crops.

EXHIBIT:

Hay (4-H 39)

· Exhibit 3-6 flakes of hay. The flakes must be string tired or wired together.

Wheat (4-H 749)

· One (1) gallon from current crop

Soybeans (4-H 209)

· Exhibit 6 soybean plants. The roots must be included and covered with a plastic bag.

Oats (4-H 749)

· Exhibit 20-30 stalks, with grain head attached, cut at ground level and tied as a shock.

Corn (4-H 672, 4-H 673, 4-H 674)

• Exhibit 3 stalks of corn. The roots must be included and covered with a plastic bag.
