

GARDEN: HERBS

Resource: HO-28; 4-H 970-W

RULES:

1. Community Judging of all 4-H Herbs projects will be at Project Check-In.
2. Maximum container size 8 inch pot.
3. Herbs should be in your care for a minimum of three months for state fair exhibits.
4. Be sure to grow the plants in the container to be displayed. Plants that have been dug from the garden or transplanted from another container immediately before exhibiting are likely to be in shock and may wilt.
5. Choose a container that is an appropriate size for the plant.
6. Herbs should be in your care for a minimum of 3 months.

EXHIBIT:

1. Each 4-H member may enter up to 3 single herbs from the list below in an 8" diameter pot.
2. All exhibits **MUST** be labeled with both common name and Latin name.
3. Planters **MUST** have drainage and provide for water retention (i.e. have a saucer under the pot).

Any exhibitor interested in exhibiting at the State Fair may enter 1 garden collection and not more than 5 single vegetables and/or 3 herbs. State Fair exhibitors should contact the Extension Office for proper tags.
