

GLOBAL EDUCATION: MY WORLD

LEVEL/GRADES

Beginner: Grades 3, 4, 5

Intermediate: Grades 6, 7, 8

Advanced: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

RULES:

1. Community Judging of all 4-H My World Projects will be at Project Check-In.
2. Posters should be displayed horizontally, sized 22" x 28", mounted on a firm backing (foam-core board or other), and covered in clear plastic or other transparent material.
3. All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

EXHIBIT:

Beginner (Grades 3-5) – The exhibit should include either a poster or display about People in My World. This could include someone special in your life, a specific group of people, or anything about People.

Intermediate (Grades 6-8) – The exhibit should include either a poster or display about Places in My World. This could include somewhere you have been, somewhere you would like to go, somewhere in the news, restaurants, stores, etc. Anything associated with Places.

Advanced (Grades 9-12) – The exhibit should include either a poster or display and a 200 word essay on People, Places, Things, or Events in My World.

NOTE: This could be a continuation from year to year or a new topic each year.
