# TRACTOR SAFETY EDUCATION (TRACTOR POSTER)

#### LEVEL/GRADES

Level A: Grades 3, 4 (Starting Up: Getting to Know Your Tractor 4-H 961)

Level B: Grades 5, 6 (Tractor Operation: Gearing Up for Safety 4-H 962)

Level C: Grades 7, 8, 9 (Moving Out: Learning About Your Tractor & Farm Machinery 4-H 963)

Level D: Grades 10, 11, 12 (Learning More: Learning About Agricultural Tractors & Equipment 4-H 964)

#### **RULES**

- 1. Community Judging of all 4-H Tractor Posters will be at Project Check-In.
- 2. Posters must displayed horizontally, sized 22" X 28", mounted on a firm backing (foam core board or other), and covered in clear plastic or other transparent material.
- 3. All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

#### **EXHIBITS**

Level A - grades 3-4

Exhibit one of the following. Do a different exhibit each year.

- Poster
- · Notebook Report
- · Display Board: Display boards differ from a poster in that real objects are normally used rather than drawings or pictures. Three-dimensional items are attached to the board.

NOTE: The subject content for the exhibit must correspond to the subject content found in the Level A manual.

LEVEL B - GRADES 5-6

Exhibit one of the following. Do a different exhibit each year.

- Poster
- · Notebook Report
- Display Board: Display boards differ from a poster in that real objects are normally used rather than drawings or pictures. Three-dimensional items are attached to the board.

NOTE: The subject matter for the exhibit must correspond to the subject matter found in the Level A or B manual.

Level C - grades 7-9

Exhibit one of the following. Do a different exhibit each year.

- · Poster
- · Notebook Report
- Display Board: Display boards differ from a poster in that real objects are normally used rather than drawings or pictures. Three-dimensional items are attached to the board.

NOTE: The subject matter for the exhibit must correspond to the subject matter found in the Level A, B, or C manual.

### Level D - grades 10-12

Exhibit one of the following. Do a different exhibit each year.

- · Poster
- · Notebook Report
- · Display Board: Display boards differ from a poster in that real objects are normally used rather than drawings or pictures. Three-dimensional items are attached to the board.

NOTE: The subject matter for the exhibit must correspond to the subject matter found in the Level A, B, C, or D manual.
