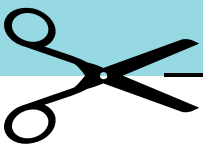

- 1 in 6 Hoosiers and more than 1 in 5 children are at risk of hunger.
- **There are nearly 30,000 people in Hamilton County who are food insecure.**
- 77% of Indiana Food Bank Clients report having to choose between paying bills or purchasing food.
- Research shows good nutrition affects growth, behavior of children, school performance and cognitive development.
- Family meals provide social interaction and learning time, and they build family unity. Families that share in mealtime provide greater nutrition, higher self-esteem and happier families.
