Dear Livestock Member:

Be sure to read through this packet of livestock information very carefully! There is information to help you be successful at the Jackson County Fair.

1) Notice of barn clean-ups **AND** note about ALL Livestock manuals.

2) Pen Reservations

Reservations are due to the Extension Office by **Friday, July 9th** (Open Class fees are **payable** upon entry of livestock at the **Fair Board Office**). There are no fees for 4-H'ers showing only 4-H animals. Please only reserve pens for animals (no single hog pens, no tack pens).

3) Consignment Sheet

Due with payment to the Extension Office by **Friday, July 9th**. Those turning in their money late (July 10th - July 23rd) will be charged a \$10.00 late fee. **NO CONSIGNMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER JULY 23rd AFTER 4:30 P.M.**

4) Two Auction Flyers

Please distribute these to businesses and encourage them to come and support the 4-H Livestock Auction on Saturday, July 31st.

5) Fair Parking Passes

This year each family will receive **3** parking passes. These parking passes will be available in the livestock packets that can be picked up on Wednesday, July 21st between 3:00 – 7:00 p.m. at project check in day at the fairgrounds. Packets not picked up on project check in day will be available for pick up at the Extension Office beginning Thursday, July 22nd.

Read these instructions carefully. It is your responsibility to submit the proper paperwork by the due date. If you have questions, call the Extension Office at 812-358-6101.

Yellow RFID tags are **unlawful** to remove! **If your animal needs retagged, contact the Extension Office as soon as possible.**

4-H members **will not be permitted** to stay overnight in the barns. Because of liability insurance, Jackson County 4-H will not sponsor or allow overnight stays on the fairgrounds.

Notification Regarding ALL 4-H Livestock:

Read all 4-H General Animal Guidelines found in the 4-H Handbook on pages 14-18 and your specific species information located on pages 18-38.

Special Beef Notification:

- Mulch will be provided in the barn free to Beef exhibitors. Stall assignments will be made by July 16th, 7:30 p.m.
- ABSOLUTELY NO SET-UP to be done prior to July 16th, NO EXCEPTIONS!

Special Goat Notification:

- All goats need a collar and a tie rope for their pens.

Special Swine Notifications:

- Swine deposit fee for pens are \$10 for each pen. Please have a check ready on Monday of fair. Make checks out to Jackson County Pork Expo. This check will be returned to you upon completion of pen cleanup after the auction on Saturday.

All Livestock Species Notifications:

- YQCA: Don't forget to print your YQCA certificate and bring it with you to check in. YQCA is an Indiana 4-H exhibit requirement for all youth exhibiting Swine, Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Beef Cattle, Sheep, Goats, Rabbits, and Poultry. If you need assistance printing the certificate, contact the Extension Office at 812-358-6101.
- Auction Photos: Watch in the barns for the times auction pictures will be taken for your species.

Notice to Beef Members

Date: Wednesday, July 28th at 7:30 a.m. – 4-H Steers, Heifers, Feeders, and Dairy Beef Animals weighed to determine 4-H Classes

4-H Beef members must check in registered heifers at scale shed on Wednesday, July 28th.

Registration papers (no photo copies) will be checked, heifers will be entered and questions will be answered. 4-H Beef and Dairy Beef members must check in steers, market heifers, commercial heifers, and feeders at scale shed on Wednesday as well. If a 4-H member cannot be present, a family member must check in for 4-H'ers. Tom Martin, Beef Chairman will be facilitating check-in.

All Livestock Members

The Jackson County Fair Board is asking for your cooperation in parking ALL Trailers in the Pyoca Lot after unloading. **Do Not** throw pop cans in the manure bins. Please use proper receptacles for pop cans and other trash.

RELEASE TIME: Please remember the release time for livestock. NO ANIMALS to be removed from the fairgrounds prior to 11:00 p.m. on Friday, July 30th except under special circumstances approved by Livestock Chairpersons. All non-auction animals need to be removed by 8:00 a.m. Saturday, July 31st.

All Livestock Manuals

4-H'ers in Beef, Dairy Beef, Cat, Dog, Boer Goat, Dairy Goat, Dairy, Horse & Pony, Poultry, Rabbit, Sheep and Swine are required to complete four activities per year in the manual. Each activity must be initialed by an adult 4-H Volunteer or 4-H Junior Leader at the appropriate locations in the books. The manuals are to be turned in at the 4-H Building on Wednesday, July 21st from 3:00 -7:00 p.m. The books will be graded and returned during the fair or with the green folders. (**Dog and Horse & Pony Books** will be turned into the Animal Club Leader to be graded and **are not** to be brought to the 4-H Building on project check in day. **Do not insert the manuals in the green folders.**

Only 4-H'ers completing their four activities will be eligible to exhibit animals, receive ribbons, and sell at the auction. **Remember, you must complete four activities!!!**

The following information is needed for us to prepare enough space for your 4-H animals at the Fair. If your form is not returned WE WILL NOT GUARANTEE SPACE for those animals at fair time. All fees for open class stall and cage rentals are payable to the Jackson County Fair Board Office when animals are entered at the fairgrounds. If you only exhibit in the 4-H Show, you do not pay fees.

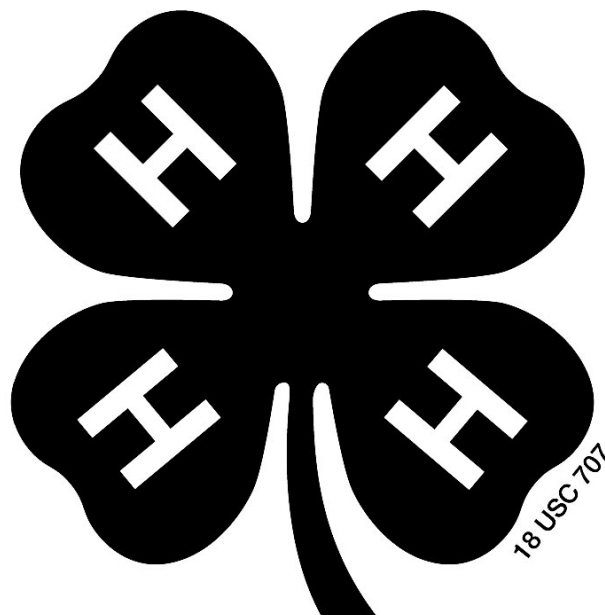
