

Sexing your rabbit:


Write next to the picture whether it is a BUCK or a DOE.



Tattooing: Place the steps to tattooing in the correct order beginning with 1 (one).

- Put the rabbit in a tattoo box or have someone hold the rabbit in a towel with ears exposed.
- _____ Put numbers and/or letters in the tattoo pliers. (A tattoo needle may also be used.)
- _____ Disinfect the pliers, letters and numbers before tattooing another animal.
- _____ Tattoo a piece of cardboard or paper first to make sure it says what you want it to.
- _____ Clean the rabbit's ear with a cotton swab soaked in alcohol.
 - _____ Rub tattoo ink into the puncture holes with a cotton swab or applicator.
- _____ Carefully tattoo the left ear with the tattoo pliers.

- 5. This medium breed originated in France and carries it's ears in the shape of a V.
- 6. Its coat color is cinnamon or rust with a uniform gray ticking across the back.
- 7. This large breed originated in Belgium, and is one of the oldest fur breeds.
- 8. This breed's coat color is white, with ears, nose, feet, and tail as near black as possible.
- 9. This large breed has a commercial profile, with a frosty white coat color with exception given for the eye bands.
- 10. This small breed originated in the Far East and is one of the oldest breeds or rabbits.
- 11. This large breed originated in the United States and has good fur and meat qualities.
- 12. This medium breed originated in Cambridge, England.
- 13. This medium wool breed has the finest texture wool of the Angora breeds.

- 1. This medium breed originated in Germany.
- 2. This small breed, originating in Holland, is bred for exhibition, pets, and laboratory use.
- 3. This breed has two varieties, golden and lynx.
- 4. This all-purpose breed originated in France and is popular for its distinctive coat qualities.
- 8. This giant breed originating in France, is ideal for meat and fur production.
