Jasper County 4-H Dairy Lease Program

Objective of the 4-H Animal Lease Program

The objective of this program is to allow youth who do not have the resources to raise/own a 4-H Dairy project the opportunity to have a project animal through leasing. The 4-H member will gain firsthand experience in the management and showing of the 4-H animal projects through the cooperation of the local animal owners.

Rules of the Lease Agreement

- 1. To be valid, the agreement must be signed by the owner, 4-H member, and parent/guardian. Upon signature of all parties involved, this Lease Agreement is subject to the rules described herein.
- 2. Only dairy heifers that will be less than two years of age at the time of the Indiana State Fair 4-H dairy show may be leased.
- 3. To be eligible for the lease program, a 4-H member must not currently own (or purchase within current project year) a dairy cow or calf.
- 4. A 4-H member may enter into only one new lease each 4-H year and up to two Dairy animals.
- 5. The term of the lease shall be the date the legal owner signs the form, until the end of the 4-H project year.
- 6. The project animal must be registered on the 4Honline website and a copy of the lease agreement must be submitted to the Ext Office by May 15th of the current year.
- 7. During the term of the agreement, the animal is a 4-H project. The 4-H member must keep a project specific 4-H Record Book and a Diary to document the actual time spent caring for the project animal. Care includes the number of visits and specific work/care performed.
- 8. The 4-H member must agree to physically care for this animal to the fullest extent possible. A care schedule will be worked out between the owner of the animal and the 4-H member.
- 9. No animal substitutions may be made after May 15th.
- 10. The Owner agrees not to sell the animal after signing the agreement and the 4-H project animal show and/or end of project year.
- 11. At the end of the lease, the Owner and 4-H member may choose to renew the agreement for another year.
- 12. All 4-H rules, policies, requirements for the Dairy animal project applies to leased animals as well.
- 13. The land owner, leader, or legal owner must be held harmless by the 4-H member, friends, family, etc. if any injuries occur unless gross negligence can be attributed to the land owner, leader, or legal owner.
