

Mini 4-H Project List



Select two (2) projects from the list below to complete and enter at the Jasper County Fair on project entry day. Watch your emails for the project entry date or contact the Jasper County Extension Office. Your project will then be on display the week of the Jasper County Fair. You will need to pick your project up from the Mini 4H display area on Friday, July 30, 2021 between 6:00 – 8:00 pm. Projects left may be disposed of.

MINI TOY FARM SCENE

Exhibit must be made using a regular size shoe box. Place your shoebox with one of its "long" side's down on the working surface and, using scissors, cut across along that long side of the shoe box so it is about 2" high from the bottom up. You will be using this as the front side so people can see your farm scene when it is on display at the fair. Place your shoebox with the bottom of the box on your work surface. Make your mini farm scene using small toy items you have at home

Ex:- small toy animal, a small farmhouse, barn, tractor etc.

You may want to make an area look like grass using grass clipping or appear as dirt in a field; get creative and have fun making your miniature "farm"

LABEL your exhibit with a tag showing your name, grade and MINI TOY FARM SCENE

Foods

Exhibit two (2) no bake cookies OR two (2) marshmallow treat squares in a one quart Ziplock type plastic bag

Include your recipe on a small index card

LABEL your exhibit with a tag showing your name, grade and MINI FOODS.

Photography

Exhibit vertically three (3) color pictures attached with adhesive to a mini poster board (11" x 14")

One picture should be of an animal, one picture should be of a person, and one picture should be of a scenery. Be creative in the way you display your photographs on your poster!

A title of MINI PHOTOGRAPHY should appear at the top of your photography poster

LABEL your exhibit with a tag showing your name and grade placed in the lower right hand corner

Flowers

Exhibit one (1) stem of your sunflower you planted at your first Mini 4H meeting in April or one (1) stem of another flower you planted this spring, in a vase NO LARGER than 9" tall and 3" wide with a neck opening of NO MORE than 1" to 3". Vase should be clear or white, NO bottles.

LABEL your exhibit with a tag showing your name, your grade and MINI FLORAL

Gardening

Exhibit three (3) garden items (ex:- 3 green beans or 3 carrots) that you have grown or helped in a garden where they were grown, on a sturdy paper plate

LABEL your exhibit with your name, your grade and MINI GARDENING
