

4-H RABBIT SCHOLARSHIP - \$250.00

WHO MAY APPLY?

1. Any 4-H member who is a graduating senior who will be continuing their education in a technical school, trade school, college, or university.
2. 4-H member should have at least 4 years of 4-H involvement in the LaPorte County Rabbit Project and be a current member. Member must complete the current year to receive the scholarship.

EXPLANATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

1. Two scholarships will be available on a yearly basis to eligible members in the LaPorte County 4-H Rabbit Program. Selection will be at the discretion of the scholarship selection committee.
2. The scholarship funds will be given directly to the recipient upon satisfactory completion of the first semester, or trade school. Written notice must be provided directly to the LaPorte County Extension Office after satisfactory completion of the above requirements.
3. The scholarship must be used during the first year of post high school education.
4. The scholarship will be awarded during the LaPorte County Fair rabbit judging.
5. One alternate will be selected for the scholarship, but will not be publicly announced.
6. Selection of the winners shall be based on the following:
 - 25% Participation in the 4-H Rabbit Program
 - 25% Leadership abilities/citizenship
 - 25% Essay
 - 25% NeedThe essay will be used to break a tie.
7. It is the policy of the Cooperative Extension Service of Purdue University that all persons shall have equal opportunity and access to its programs and facilities without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, age, or handicap.
8. Return application to LaPorte County Extension Office by July 7.
