Get ready for an adventure around the world at the Southern Indiana 4-H Camp. Camp will be held June 2-4! 4-H members in grades 3-8 are invited to join this international experience for a fabulous camping excursion. Camp will be at Country Lake Retreat Center in Clark County. Check-in is Friday, June 2 from 9am-10am and pick up is at Noon on Sunday, June 4. With a group of thirteen counties camping together, you're sure to make new friends. Invite your friends to join us. Be sure to let them know they must officially join 4-H in order to register for camp! Our Travel Around the World Camp Theme will be a lot of fun.

The total cost of camp is \$195. Contact your county's Extension Office for additional information regarding available scholarships. The registration fee includes all activity and class supplies, buffet meals, snacks, and a 4-H Camp t-shirt. The international place we will be staying does not allow outside food, so please do not bring personal snacks or drinks to camp. No worries my wanderers, snacks are included in the price of camp. **There's no need to bring any money to camp.**

Travel Awaits! There's limited space at 4-H Camp so get signed up quickly! All 4-H Camp registrations are being submitted through 4HOnline under the event name **Southern Indiana 4-H Camp**. Lawrence County will be listed as registration county. No worries that is the county that created the event and not the county you are a 4-H member in. Visit <https://4honline.com> to register. Instructions for how to register are attached. Payment can be made via check and turned in to the Purdue Extension Office or online with credit card. Your registration is due in 4HOnline by **May 1, 2023**. Health forms must be completed via 4HOnline. Changes can be presented during check-in at camp.

Once you have enrolled in camp, be on the lookout after May 10 for a confirmation letter, including information about what to bring to camp. All good explorers will want to be prepared for this traveling adventure including canoeing, fishing, swimming in the lake or pool, crafts, recreation, and special classes. Campers get to choose the classes they want to take at 4-H Camp. Be sure to enter your class choices in 4HOnline. Class choices will be on first come, first serve basis, so be sure to register ASAP to get the classes you want!
