Tagging/Weigh-In Schedule

New this year! You have two options of when to attend Animal Tagging/Weigh In. You can choose to attend this mandatory event for most of our animal projects April 30 (5-7 pm) or May 11 (AM) at the Lawrence County 4-H Fairgrounds. Each species that has a weigh-in/tagging will be expected to attend one of these dates. If you would like to participate in the Rate of Gain classes, plan to attend on May 11. Excluded animals are cats, dogs, horses, poultry, and dairy calves that are not born by this date. These will have separate dates they must attend. In addition to learning technical and mechanical skills from their restoration, participants develop teamwork, project management, budget management, planning and marketing skills.

The competition awards prizes totaling up to \$20,000. Whether you're involved with FFA, 4-H, Skills USA, or simply interested in agriculture and/or the restoration process, the Chevron TRC is a rewarding experience which engages you.

- August 2 Competition deadline for all entry materials including Restoration Reports, videos, and photos
- September 11 Finalists will be announced on social media
- October 23-24 TRC Finals: In-person finalist presentations will take place in Indianapolis, IN, colocated with the 2024 FFA National Expo

4HOnline: Double Check your Record

Now that you have completed your enrollment through https://4HOnline.com, we recommend you bookmark the site. You will use this site throughout the year to do things like:

- Drop/Add projects —to be eligible to exhibit a project at the fair, be sure to have it on your 4HOnline profile to complete Fairentry. *If you decide to drop or add projects, email McKayla with your changes.
- Identify your animals--May 15!
- Animal Identification can be completed after January
 15 and must be completed by May 15.
- Sign up for trips and activities
