## Heart

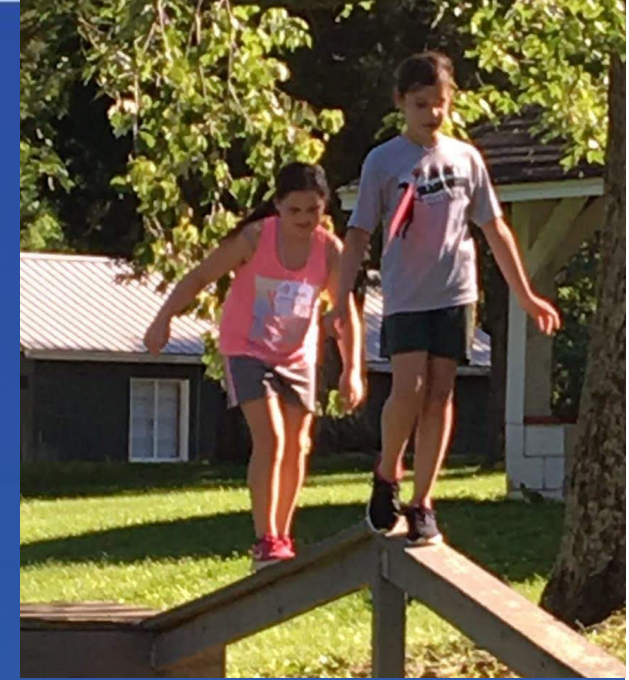
Give your child the gift of a camp experience they will LOVE!
