Swine 4-H tags will be available during office hours 8 am – 4 pm and with pre-arrangement by texting 812-653-2089 or calling 812-295-2412. Before swine tags are issued, families will need to know the exhibitors name, each animal's breed, sex, notches, tattoo if applicable and if each animal has any other type of tag applied so the correct tag may be issued for each animal. Swine tags to be applied by May 15th and no animals to be checked in at the 4-H Fair livestock check-in without tags applied. Swine tags to be applied by May 15th and no animals will be checked in at the 4-H Fair livestock check-in without tags applied.
