All exhibits must attach a completed county exhibit tag and a "Create Your Own Thing" Information Card with a description of work completed on the project.

Level 2: Grade 6 thru 8

Exhibit your self-determined project. You may show, in any way you like, what you have accomplished in the project. Your project record sheet should accompany your exhibit. Project can't exceed 30 inches in any direction. All exhibits must attach a completed county exhibit tag and a "Create Your Own Thing" Information Card with a description of work completed on the project.

Level 3: Grade 9 thru 12

Exhibit your self-determined project. You may show, in any way you like, what you have accomplished in the project. Your project record sheet should accompany your exhibit. Project can't exceed 30 inches in any direction. All exhibits must attach a completed county exhibit tag and a "Create Your Own Thing" Information Card with a description of work completed on the project.
