MODELS

This objective of this project is to allow 4-H'ers to be creative and skillful. A wide variety of things may be done in the Arts and Crafts project. Arts and Crafts can express many talents of a 4-H'er.

RULES

Attach to project - 4-H-618A-W "4-H Craft Information Card" for description of work completed on the project.

If multiple pieces make up the exhibit, a photograph of the complete exhibit should be attached to the exhibit so the total exhibit can properly be displayed. For safety purposes any craft exhibit that resembles a sword, knife, or look-a-like weapon will be judged but will not be displayed.

REQUIREMENTS:

All exhibits must be a small scale replica and meet the following criteria:

- Must be of injected styrene plastics
- At least 25% of the exhibit must be painted
- Wood, paper, clay, die-cast, or snap together models are not permitted
- Screws are not permitted
- Pre-painted or pre-decaled factory models are not permitted
- If the model is being built from a kit, include a copy of the instructions with the craft information card.
- Legos are not considered models and to be exhibited as *Any Other Craft* or a *Construction Toy Model*.

<u>DIVISION I (grades 3-4)</u>: Exhibit one painted small-scale replica model. Model must be mounted on a piece of Styrofoam or other similar means that extends no more than 1 inch on all sides of the model. This will help eliminate handling or possible damage to your model.

<u>DIVISION II (grades 5-6)</u>: Exhibit one painted small-scale replica model. Model must be mounted on a piece of Styrofoam or other similar means that extends no more than one inch on all sides of the model. This will help eliminate handling or possible damage to your model.

<u>DIVISION III (grades 7-8)</u>: Exhibit one painted small-scale replica. Exhibit must be mounted on a piece of Styrofoam or other means that extends no more than one inch on all sides of the model. Exhibit could be an airplane, spaceship, road vehicle, etc.

<u>DIVISION IV AND ABOVE (grades 9-12)</u>: Exhibit three to five painted small-scale replica models. Exhibit must be mounted on a piece of Styrofoam or other means and must be no larger than 2 feet by 3 feet. EXAMPLE: Tractor and trailer are two models.
