2024 Indiana 4-H Animal Identification

The following table lists the different animal species and the respective form of identification that is required for a 4-H member to be eligible to show in the 4-H livestock shows at the 2024 Parke County 4-H Fair and the Indiana State Fair. The animal ID information must be entered in the Indiana 4-H Online enrollment system by May 15th for all species. Missing, incomplete or incorrect animal ID information could result in ineligibility for that particular animal.



Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care or YQCA certification is required for all beef, dairy, swine, sheep, goat, poultry, and rabbit exhibitors. Parke County trainings have been set. You can find those dates online at extension purdue edu/parke and click on the 4-H tab. Annual certification must be completed by June 21st.

Swine tags may be picked up at the Extension Office and are \$3 per tag. Sheep and Goat tag-in will be May 11th from 9am-11am in the Sheep/Goat Barn.
