

Animal ID Requirements—County Only 2022

BEEF Steers & Commercial Heifers—County Only

- 840 RFID tag
- County tag

BEEF Registered Heifers—County Only

- 840 RFID tag
- Tattoo in the ear that matches registration papers

DAIRY—County Only

- 840 RFID tag
- Tattoo in the ear that matches registration papers
- If they are not registered, they need a County Tag

MEAT GOAT Registered Female—County Only

- No tags to pick up from Extension Office
- Tattoo in the ear that matches registration papers

MEAT GOAT Unregistered Male & Female—County Only

- Scrapie Tag or Shearwell Tag
 - If the animal has a scrapie tag (the tag will have a US Shield on it), then they do not need any tags from Extension Office.

SHEEP Females and Males (Market Lambs & Commercial Ewes)—County Only

- Scrapie Tag or Shearwell Tag
 - If the animal has a scrapie tag (the tag will have a US Shield on it), then they do not need any tags from Extension Office

SHEEP Registered Ewes—County Only

- ID that matches registration papers
- Scrapie Tag or Shearwell tag

SWINE County Only

- 840 tag will be given at the Fair check-in
- Ear notch
 - For animal ID on 4-H Online, use the ear notches
