Countdown to the Fair

Use this checklist of information to prepare for the Fair!

- Fair Entry—submit entries by June 19. All 4-H'ers required to complete.
- Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care/YQCA—livestock exhibitors must complete by July 1
- Pre-Fair Cleanup
 - Sunday, July 7—Kings & Queens and Victory Bees 4-H Clubs
 - If you are a member of these clubs, you are responsible for helping cleanup the Exhibit Building. Please bring cleaning supplies such as window cleaner, paper towels, trash bags, water buckets, rags, brooms, squeegees. Please arrive by 1:00 PM.
 - Saturday, July 13—All remaining 4-H clubs and leaders.
 - If your club did not help on July 7, then you are responsible for helping cleanup the remainder of the fairgrounds. Areas to be cleaned include: around all the buildings on the fairgrounds and livestock barns. Livestock exhibitors are expected to help in their barns. Please bring the following tools to help: hammers, saws, nails, wire cutters, trash bags, push mowers, riding mowers, gloves, weed eaters, safety glasses, rakes, water buckets, rags, shovels, wheel barrows, garden hoses, pruners, drills, extension cords, dust pans, brooms. Please arrive by 7AM.
 - For exhibitors that didn't receive their Fair passes by this time, there will be a booth set up by the livestock barns with Fair passes and t-shirts.
- Project Check-Ins
 - Wednesday, July 10—Static projects are checked in at the Exhibit Building: aerospace, americana, animal posters, arts & crafts, beekeeping, child development, collections, communications (creative writing), computer, , egg, electric, entomology, family camping, forestry, genealogy, geology, health, home environment, photography, recycling, scrapbooking, small engines, soil & water science, sportfishing, sports, tractor poster, travelogue, veterinary science, weather, wildlife, woodworking, secretary books, ten year/last year member boards

NEW IN 2024: Eggs will only be checked in at the Poultry Show on Tuesday, July 16 at 7:30 AM.

Community judging in the exhibit building on July 10 will include: construction toys, consumer clothing, farm scene, models, pet pals, sewing.

Club banners and displays turned in on July 10.

Check-in will be from 5-7 PM. If you are unable to make check-in, please reach out. We are willing to work with you.

 Sunday, July 14—check-in cake decorating, cupcake decorating, foods, food preservation, and flowers. Projects will be community judged in the Community Center from 1-3 PM (NEW 2024).

Corn production, corn science, soybean production, soybean science and garden will be checked in at the exhibit building from 1-3PM.

Foods will be donated for the 4-H Food Auction on Monday, July 15.

- Poultry and Rabbits will be checked out from 7-9 PM on Thursday, July 18.
- <u>NEW 2024:</u> 1st Opportunity to check-out static projects—Friday, July 19 12-1 PM in the Exhibit Building
 - Families will have the chance to check-out projects in the Exhibit Building starting at 12 PM.
 - Premium money will be available to pick up in the Exhibit Building from 12-1 PM.
 Non-perishable State Fair selected projects can stay so that they can be transported to the State Fair later in July.
- <u>NEW 2024:</u> 2nd Opportunity to check-out static projects—Friday, July 19 5-7 PM in the Exhibit Building
 - This will be the final chance to pick up projects in the Exhibit Building.
 - Premium money will be available to pick up in the Exhibit Building from 5-7 PM. Non-perishable State Fair selected projects can stay so that they can be transported to the State Fair later in July.
 - IF YOU DO NOT PICK UP PROJECTS BY JULY 19 AT 7PM, THEY WILL BE THROWN AWAY. Premium money will not be available after 7 PM.
 - The Exhibit building will be closed from 1-5 PM on Friday, July 19.
- Animal Release: livestock not going through the auction can be checked out after the Livestock Auction on Friday, July 19 from 12-4 PM.

Fair Cleanup

Mandatory for Most Animal Exhibitors:

Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care (IQLC)

To exhibit beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry and rabbits, 4-H members must be certified through a quality livestock care program.

Deadline to complete Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care training or YQCA (online) is July 1. Email completion certificates from YQCA to bender14@purdue.edu

Poultry Blood Testing
