Animal Information

Animal ID Deadline—May 15

Animal ID tags may be picked up in the Extension Office—for ID Charts, visit https://extension.purdue.edu/news/county/posey/2021/08/Posey-County-4-H-Program.htm

State Fair animals, contact the Extension Office for additional tagging information.

All animal identification is to be submitted on 4-H Online by May 15. Animals not enrolled by this deadline cannot be exhibited at the county or state fair.

Poultry Blood Testing

4-H'ers exhibiting poultry at the fair, must have their animals' blood tested prior to the fair. Questions? Contact Poultry Superintendent, Laura Kuhn.

- When: July 5 and July 7
- Where: Poultry Barn on the Fairgrounds
- Time: 6-6:30 both nights

Fair Entry—Animal Entry

4-H'ers exhibiting animals at the fair will also need to enroll them in classes on Fair Entry. This is how show bills are created. Deadline is June 15.

Youth Quality Care Assurance Certification Process (YQCA)

Just like last year, to exhibit **beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry and rabbits**, 4-H members must be certified through the YQCA program.

Training dates will be as follows at the Community Center on the Fairgrounds:

- May 12 6-7PM
- June 16 6-7PM

Deadline to complete YQCA is July 1.

Youth need only attend one session, and Mini 4-H exhibitors are exempt at this time. In-person trainings cost \$3 each and are paid for via a coupon code courtesy of 4-H Council. Please email Amanda at bender14@purdue.edu to obtain a coupon code and directions on how to register for a training via 4HOnline. Youth must register for and complete YQCA training prior to July 1 in order to participate in this year's Posey County 4-H Fair.

Mini 4-H
