IMPORTANT: If you were in 4-H last year, you are already in the online system regardless of how you enrolled (online or paper enrollment). When you go to re-enroll this year, please DO NOT set up a whole new 4HOnline profile. In order to enroll through the online system, you will need to login with your email and password.


- If you had an account in 4-H Online version 1.0, go to http://v2.4honline.com.

If you have forgotten your password, click "Reset Password?" to receive an email with a link to set a new password.







- Once all of your Clubs are added, click Next at the bottom of the screen.






- 8. Select the Club with which you want your project to be associated.

You will receive an email to let you know your enrollment has been submitted. You will receive another email when your County Extension office has approved your enrollment. You may view the enrollment status on the Member List. Any enrollments that have fees to be paid by credit card will process when the County Extension Office approves the enrollment. Should the transaction be declined, you will receive an email notification. It will include a link to login so that you may add another card or change your payment method.

4-H Program Fee

There is a \$20.00 program fee to join 4-H (grades 3-12) Of that, \$5.00 is the county fee; \$15.00 is the state fee. In regards to the state fee, the maximum number of youth a family pays for is three. However, every child must pay the county fees, regardless of family size. Fees can be paid with cash, check or credit card (online only).

If you are in grades 7-12 and want to be more involved, here is your chance to do just that! The Randolph County Junior Leaders meet each month. Junior Leaders is a group that is open to all 4-Hers in Grade 7 through 12. This lively group has a program planned each month.
