If funds are limited for a particular trip, you will be notified prior to official registration. A \$40 non-refundable deposit will be required on all 6-12th grade trips** (if submitting via check, please make payable to the Steuben County 4-H Fair Board). **If you are selected for a trip, 4-H Fair Board funds are disbursed, and you fail to attend, you will be responsible for reimbursing the 4-H Fair Board the full amount of your trip.** If there are other 4-H trips you wish to attend that pop up during the year, not listed here, simply present your request to the 4-H Fair Board for potential funding.

	State 4-H Chorus: Dynamic, talented youth will experience concentrated and inspiring musical workshops focused on singing, dance, and performance. Attendees will perform for 4-H Round-up delegates at Purdue. The cost is \$225 and is sponsored by the Steuben County 4-H Fair Board, so you will only be responsible for transportation and some meals. Written application requiring recommendation letters! 	4-H Round-Up: Will you have completed 7th, 8th, or 9th grade by this summer? Then get ready, because you are eligible to attend one of the best 4-H trips ever—Round-Up! It is held at Purdue University, and is jam-packed with fun! You will have three days to explore career options through active learning, develop leadership abilities, meet other 4-H'ers from all over the state of Indiana, and get a taste of college life. The cost of this trip is \$180.00 and is sponsored by the Steuben County 4-H Fair Board, with transportation included.	7-9	June 20-22	\$180, but you only pay \$40!
	Citizenship Washington Focus: Have you ever wanted to travel to Washington, D.C.? Each delegate will take part in workshops on contemporary issues, learn about government, and meet youth from across the US as they learn more about the true meaning of civic engagement. The cost of the trip is \$1,500.00. The Steuben County 4-H Fair Board covers half of the cost. You will be responsible for transportation to Purdue University, where a charter bus will then take you to D.C.! DUE BY MARCH 15!	Age 15+	June 25- July 1	\$1,500, but you only pay \$750!
	National Dairy Conference: This trip is for those who have completed the Dairy project for at least three years. Youth will gather in Madison, WI to learn about production, processing, marketing, and use of dairy products, as well as careers in the Dairy industry. The cost was not determined at the time of printing, but is subsidized by the Steuben County 4-H Fair Board. You will be responsible for transportation to Purdue University, where a bus will take you to Madison, WI.	9-12	October 2-6	TBD
	National 4-H Congress: This premier trip is held in Atlanta, GA. Youth will participate in educational workshops focusing on diversity, cultural experiences, leadership, and team development. Only 9 Indiana 4-H members will be selected to attend! Your expenses will include spending money. Written application requiring recommendation letters! Start early!	9-12	November 25-29	\$600, if selected, but you only pay \$40!
	National 4-H Conference: Attend the annual premier national civic engagement opportunity for 4-H members. Delegates will have the opportunity choose an important societal topic, and prepare a briefing. During the conference, groups present their briefing to federal officials around the Washington, D.C. area. One to four delegates will represent Indiana. You will be responsible for transportation to Purdue University, where a charter bus will then take you to D.C.! Written application is due in early January annually via 4HOnline!	10-12	March 2023	\$600, if selected, but you only pay \$40! Plan on about \$100 in incidentals.
