Teens as Teachers

Teams of 3-5 youth (grades 8-11) learn how to be teachers and subject matter experts of a topic of their choice. Teens will be equipped to deliver programs in the community.

3 virtual, one-hour sessions will be held on February 9, 16, and 23, each from 7-8 p.m. (ET) - these are designed to give youth the basics of how to be an effective teen teacher. The final session will be held on February 27, from 10 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Youth will join together with their team for an in-person training facilitated by presenters joining virtually. This session will focus on the subject matter.

Subject matter options: Ag Innovators Experience: "Curbing Our Carbon Appetite Challenge," Animal Biosecurity, Computer Science, Healthy Living, Teen Leadership, and Fluid Power.

To exhibit beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry and rabbits, 4-H members MUST be certified through by July 9, 2021 (Mini 4-H exempt). This is an annual education program that can be completed via online modules (\$12) or in-person training programs(\$3). In-person trainings held in Vigo County will be free to Vigo County 4-H members that enrolled by January 15th. Thank you to Rural King and The Equity for sponsoring.
