PHILOSOPHY OF AWARDS GIVEN AT ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM

We believe in rewarding 4-H members for their efforts in many different ways. The incentive most 4-H members are familiar with is the ribbon or trophy awarded at the County Fair for an exhibit prepared for display. However, the core of the incentive program seeks to reward the knowledge and skills found through a particular 4-H project, activity or program highlighting what they have *learned* in the project, as well as how it was learned. Achievement Awards reward the *growth* of project requirements or by pursuit of one phase of an activity for deeper understanding. The awards committee in the fall and winter is concerned with the county achievement pin selection. Achievement pins are given in each project for a 4-H member's achievement during that particular year. Project achievement pins are awarded on the basis of one pin for every ten-project exhibit/completions. Trips are awarded on a project completed/age/grade combination to meet both county and state guidelines. Selection is based upon work done by the 4-H member in an individual project as shown by the White Achievement Card "My Record of 4-H Achievement". Selection of these awards is made first from the evaluation of (1) Information learned reported on the front of the card and then: (2) Project work reported on the front of the card (3) Demonstrations given (4) Judging activities completed (5) Committee Work (6) Meetings/Workshops attended (7) Community Service (8) Leadership demonstrated and (9) Other 4-H activities.

If a 4-Her cannot take the trip he/she is awarded and does not notify the Extension Office that they will not be taking the trip prior to **March 1st**, and a replacement is not found, the 4-H member will be required to reimburse the 4-H Council for the amount of the trip and transportation fees, if applicable. This includes all State and National trips, as well as, 4-H Choir and 4-H Band. A signed behavior form and acceptance or a non-acceptance of trip must be on file at the Warrick County Extension Office for each trip.

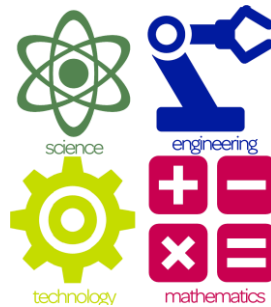
