AWARD APPLICATIONS:

The Caley Memorial Award is given annually to two 4-H Members in Wells County who have shown outstanding qualities in the area of leadership, citizenship, sportsmanship, and personality in their community, school, church, and 4-H activities. Applicants must be at least 14 years of age to be eligible. **Applications are due on Friday, June 21st.** You can find the requirements and application on our website www.extension.purdue.edu/wells



Each year four candidates are selected to represent the Wells County 4-H Fair as Junior Ambassadors (2) and Senior Ambassadors (2). Ambassadors will assist the 4-H Association with 4-H events and at the Wells County 4-H Fair. Junior Ambassador applicants must be in grades 7-9th, and Senior Ambassador applicants must be in grade 10 or above. 4-H Ambassador applications are due on Friday, June 21st. DUE IN JULY:

QLC/YQCA training is due on Monday, July 1st.

- 3. Sign in using your 4-H Online email and password. <u>DO NOT CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT</u>
- 4. Click "Create Invoice" or "Begin Work on a New Invoice"
- 5. Next to the member's name, click "Create Entry"
- 6. Select the correct department, division, & class for the entry
- 7. If a livestock project (Not Including Poultry), select "Add Animal"
 - a. Then select "Choose an Existing Animal Record"
- 8. The next screen with have three choices:
 - a. "Add Another Entry"
 - b. "Register Another Exhibit"
 - c. "Continue to Payment"
- 9. After clicking "Continue to Payment" you will see a total cost of \$0.00. Click Continue
- 10. Click Submit. <u>DO NOT SUBMIT UNTIL ALL ENTRIES</u>
 ARE COMPLETED FOR ALL CHILDREN
